

Standards for Ethics

Introduction

Physiotherapists/physical therapists are accountable for providing high-quality, competent and ethical services. The Standards for Ethics are reflected in the Code of Ethics. The Code of Ethics describes the values that guide Ontario physiotherapists in making ethical choices that are in the best interest of their patients. Physical therapists are expected to apply these values in all aspects of the patient-physiotherapist (or therapeutic) relationship and in practice management decisions that impact that relationship.

The Code of Ethics is supported by a decision-making tool and an online E-learning module.
