

Standards for Professional Ethics

Introduction

Physiotherapists are accountable for providing high quality, competent and ethical services. The Code of Ethics for Physiotherapists describes the values that guide physiotherapists in making ethical choices in clinical practice that are in the best interests of their patients. Registrants are expected to apply these values in all aspects of the patient-physiotherapist relationship and in practice management decisions that impact that relationship.

The Code of Ethics is supported by a decision-making tool and an online learning module.

Along with The Code of Ethics, physiotherapists must also consider relevant legislation, standards of practice and policies in their jurisdiction and workplace.
