Protecting Your Organization Against Cyber Attacks

Cyberattacks are on the rise, and it's more important than ever for organizations to protect the information entrusted to them by their employees and members of the public. Between 2020 and 2021, global ransomware attacks increased by 151 percent.

In Canada, the Canadian Internet Registration Authority reports that 60 percent more

organizations reported breaches of customer and employee data in 2021 than before the pandemic began in 2020.

In October, the Information and Privacy Commissioner of Ontario (IPC) issued an [updated technology fact sheet](#) to help organizations prevent ransomware attacks.

Physiotherapists must continue to follow the rules of the Personal Health Information Protection Act (PHIPA), and should stay up to date with guidance from the IPC to help protect the privacy of their patients.

Collaborative Care Standard

Physiotherapists must collaborate with patients and others when relevant to the patient's plan of care.

The Collaborative Care Standard details the responsibilities of a physiotherapist when collaborating with patients and other relevant service providers when relevant to the patient's physiotherapy plan of care.

Advice from the Practice Advisors when it comes to collaborative care:

A physiotherapist must work with the patient to create a plan of care that addresses the patient's needs and goals, and help the patient understand their role in the plan.

Stop Making Assumptions: Don't assume that you know what the patient wants from the physiotherapy session.

Start Including the Patient in Setting Physiotherapy Goals: A meaningful goal can maximize patient engagement and motivate a patient to participate in rehabilitation in order to achieve their goals. Be sure to document the goals.
